The story is set in Anatevka, during 1905. Unrest grips the country due to a rise of anti-Tsarist sentiment whilst Jews are driven from their homes by growing anti-Semitism.

The historical realities of the time do not simply provide a colourful backdrop to this story; they are central to all that transpires. A central theme is how the old traditions are disintegrating under the pressure of a culture

that is being re-shaped by industrialisation.

Tevye must cope with both the actions of his three strong willed older daughters - each one's choice of husband moves further away from the customs of his faith - and with the edict of the Tsar that evicts them from Anatevka.
